Visioning, Mariners Cove Island

As the last island, there is opportunity to create a series of built form typologies that will set the tone for built form on the island and inform design guidelines for this area. Research undertaken involved looking at existing successful and unsuccessful canal developments; what building forms do you see at the canal edge and what makes these buildings special. The elements of a 'boathouse' were used as cues including repetitive forms, gable ends, deeply recessed and sheltered volumes, the use of weatherboard and colour and in some cases the way in which the houses engage directly with the water's edge. A number of sites were identified and tested via architectural solutions.

Carnarvon Marina

This project encompasses the redevelopment of an existing Yacht Club to expand its marina area and provide new residential land and house packages, mixed use sites and a new clubhouse facility. It will be a destination to Carnarvon's current facine walk, which will be upgraded, via playground, park and cafe facilities and create a vibrant destination and stop-over for yachties travelling north. Housing has been designed to extend over the water to make the most of being in a marina environment. When you are out on the deck you'll hear the water lapping the rocks beneath you and sparkle through the timber decking.

450 Newcastle Street, Northbridge

A mixed use development comprising office space and 33 apartments to the upper levels. The site is a long, narrow lot with the narrow boundary being the Newcastle Street frontage and the northern aspect; presenting a challenge to provide for access to natural light. The resulting design creates two buildings linked by a central atrium walkway space which allows natural light and ventilation to access all levels. The two building halves respond to surrounding development height datum and references to provide for an integrated streetscape design. Surrounding built form represents varied architectural styles so this building uses a white palette of varied textures so as not to compete but to integrate with the surrounds. The entry element and atrium space is the only significant colour reference to highlight entry to the development.

Regional Town Masterplanning/Visioning

This study looked at what impact a fluctuating population will have on the town. Population projections were provided which formed the basis of yield analysis studies on how to expand the town within its existing footprint and then how to shrink it as need declines. We focused on the walkable catchment around the town centre and rationalised under-utilised spaces, reviewed housing types and development patterns for flexible housing that can cater for a varied workforce. A number of development patterns were identified based on varying conditions - both for subdivision and built form additions and alterations. The only prerequisite was that no houses were to be demolished. Significant alteration was proposed within the 10 minute walk from the town centre and a large range of opportunities within the town centre itself were presented.

Rivergums Display Village

A series of four houses for a display village at the Rivergums. Each house represents a different stage of the same plan which can be built in modular packages to cater for various family life cycles and financial constraints, each with four different elevation options. The aim was to provide an apartment style of living in the first stage with high quality finishes - granite bench tops, interior cabinetwork with the final package aimed at the family unit. All designs orientated living areas to the north and via a courtyard design every room received north light, ventilation and access to an outdoor area.
